Support to on-board active and new-construction surface ships is required.

Responsibilities:

- Support project budget development for new construction classes of surface ships by identifying the project requirements, time phasing of activities, and developing the final estimate;
- Support Damage Control automation product design development and life cycle support efforts;
- Accommodate periodic travel when required for shipboard installations and testing;
- Identify technical issues, propose solutions and manage implementation to support project execution;
- Develop all NAVSEA ILS required data/information to support logistical requirements for applicable systems;
- Able to work both independently and with a team in a fast-paced environment;
- Take ownership of assigned projects and continually look for improvement opportunities.
